Intent: What do we aim to deliver?

A love of languages will be inspired in children.

Children will gain a deeper cultural understanding, appreciation, respect and tolerance of French culture.

Children will be confident to structure key sentences in their writing, and encouraged to challenge themselves, using French dictionaries to support their exploration.

All children will leave Holmer Green Junior School able to confidently engage in basic conversation in French.

All children will have the opportunity to learn and apply their understanding so they feel prepared and excited for future language learning in KS3.

MFL lessons are taught weekly for approximately forty-five minutes every other half-term.

Implementation: How do we aim to deliver this?

The '**CGP Salut!**' programme will be used to structure French lessons throughout the school, ensuring children learn French through playing educational games and learning catchy songs and rhymes. Children will have frequent opportunities for written and oral practice.

At the start of every French unit, children will be provided with a **knowledge organiser**, recapping key vocabulary and knowledge that will be taught throughout the unit. Children will utilise this in every lesson.

In co-ordination with the Senior School, a **French market** will be held annually in school, allowing all pupils to practice their French skills in an everyday setting.

'CGP Salut!' **resources** will be used to **structure and scaffold learning**, ensuring all pupils are actively engaged in lessons and find learning accessible.



At the start of every French lesson, clear **retrieval activities** will be planned for, ensuring all pupils can remember key knowledge and vocabulary that has been taught previously.

Assessments will be created and delivered at the **end of every unit**, ensuring children can show a good understanding of the unit covered and can recall all essential vocabulary.



Impact: How will we know when we have delivered it?

High levels of Engagement and Enjoyment

Children will express enjoyment towards the subject and enthusiasm during lessons. They will develop the confidence to 'have a go' using prior knowledge to support them.

Ensuring Progress

Retrieval Practice and End of Unit assessments will be used to assess the children's language knowledge and understanding. These will be analysed and misconceptions addressed.

Whole Curriculum Impact

The MFL curriculum will work alongside all other subjects, but particularly RE and PSHE, challenging racial prejudices, insularity and intolerance towards other cultures.

Future Language Learning

Children will leave Holmer Green keen to engage in future language learning and acquisition in KS3 and beyond.
